# **Current Month Activity:**

# Ordinary Street and Sewer Maintenance

Notices of Award have been sent to the following contractors for the following Lots: Sanitary sewer maintenance to A Gargiule & Sons for Lots 1, 2, 5, & 6 for an initial contract award of \$50,000 with incremental increases as work is identified; Street maintenance to A.F. Damon for Lots 4 & 8 for an initial contract award of \$50,000 with incremental increases as work is identified; and Storm Sewer Maintenance to Ernel, Co. for Lots 1, 3, 5, & 7 with an initial contract award of \$25,000 with incremental increases as work is identified. Contracts are in the process of being prepared and executed.

A to U completed the inlet repairs at Southridge and Crestview. They have completed the sidewalk and curbing replacement and also the fence installation.

#### Grants

2017 CDBG: Delivery of the soccer field netting is the final item to be completed.

2021 CDBG: Applications are due on January 6, 2021. The Borough is able to apply for two projects. It is recommended that the Borough applies to use grant funds as a match for the 2018 PA Small Water and Sewer Grant and also to repair the sanitary sewer system on North 2<sup>nd</sup> Street. Public input will be obtained on December 17, 2020 at 7:15 PM.

# Stormwater Tip:

Clear debris from your gutters and downspouts to allow rain and melting snow to flow and not collect at your foundation. Add extensions to your downspouts so they discharge 10 feet from your foundation, and to a pervious surface, ie, grass.
