FY 2017 CDBG – Development of the soccer field

The contractor has completed the grading and top soil placement of the soccer field. The contractor still needs to place the equipment on the field.

FY 2019 CDBG - Sanitary Sewer Improvements at Golf Road

Eagle Contracting has completed this project.

<u>FY 2020 CDBG</u> – An application for using CDBG funds as a supplement to the 2018 PA Small Water and Sewer Grant for the replacement of the sanitary sewer and street resurfacing of 13th St was submitted on 1/9/2020. This grant was not awarded to the Borough. Alternatively, the Borough has submitted an application that is in front of County Council for the sanitary sewer replacement on the two hundred block of N. 2nd St. Emergency sewer repairs have been made to mitigate a backup; but, more permanent repairs are required. This application was not awarded to the Borough. It is suggested this project be submitted under the FY 21 CDBG program.

2018 PA Small Water and Sewer Grant

The Borough has not begun this project for the replacement of the sanitary sewer main and street laterals due to the lack of required matching funds. This grant expires June 30, 2021.

Ordinary Street and Sewer Maintenance

NDI will be preparing the Ordinary Street and Sewer Maintenance bids in order to have contract awards in October.

MS4 Separate Storm Sewer Permit

The annual report is due on September 30, 2020.

Stormwater Tip:

Bag, compost, or recycle grass, tree limbs, leaves and other yard waste. Wet yard waste is a major contributor to clogged storm drains and leads to street flooding.
